Safety KC:

- We need to make sure pilots are communicating at the pilot's stations. Make sure you announce:
 - Coming out
 - Taking Off and Direction
 - Landing and Direction
 - Low Passes
 - Touch and Goes.
- Also make sure you are flying the correct pattern if more than one person is flying based on wind direction at time of take-off.

Field Maintenance

- KC has scheduled a work party for Saturday, July 23rd. This will involve multiple maintenance efforts.
 - We will need someone that has a truck and dump trailer to be able to make multiple trips from the quarry to the field to put crushed rock on the entry road to fill in potholes, muddy spots and at the gate entrance. We'll need to have people with shovels and rakes to spread the gravel.
 - A couple of the members have offered their tractors with brush hogs to knock down the scotch broom. Paul Fleming has said that he could bring his weed sprayer to get the scotch broom that the tractors can't reach.
 - Those individuals that have had the chainsaw safety training from the County will need to bring their chainsaws to help cut down the larger scotch broom area north of the field. We'll need people with weed-eaters that have brush cutting blades to bring them out to clean up the area at the north end of the field.



- We also need to patch a few places on the runway from prop strikes. We will try some “Flex Seal” this time.
- The Club will have pizza for lunch and water.
- The next Field Mowing will be Monday, August 1st, weather permitting. This may change if conditions warrant it.
