Safety:

KC made a brief review of the small fire we reported in the woods west of our runway. The cause is unknown, but we must be fire aware during this dry season.

Duane brought up that before last month's meeting a new member asked if he could fly from the west side of the runway due to the low sun being in his eyes at the west end of the field. There was too many flying to allow this at that time. This is only possible if you are the only one at the field or there are just a couple of you and ALL present agree upon it. Otherwise, the only approved pilot location for flying is behind one of the four designated pilot stations.

Duane also reminded everyone that the field rules require flyers to place their AMA/Club card on the KIOSK board prior to operating any transmitter.
